I don't know, I was prepping myself for like a negative response, I had a plan in place on how to deal with that happening, but just a totally like, neutral response??

Not gonna lie Fin you really know how to make a girl confused...

Anyways, I think it would be cool if you told me a bit about yourself! Only if you want to of course... It could be fun though!

Getting to know someone else here on The Train, it gets pretty lonely here! I mean I know that's the point but sometimes the isolation really gets to me.

How about you? With the way you responded I'm sure you probably enjoy the quiet. Not to say you're a loner! Or anything else negative about you!! I don't know you, like at all. I'm sure you're a good person... probably. No, that's not a good thing to assume about a stranger. You are more than likely a good person! I would love to get to know you better.

I would love to get to know you better. And hey, maybe a biiiiit more than just one line would be nice!

Thanks for talking! Or well, at least trying to?

But sorry, I was getting a little sidetracked, don't need to give away my whole life story haha. All this is to say, I'm your currently-unnamed neighbor, and... I think that I might be transgender. I don't know what I'm hoping to accomplish with this letter, but just being able to put this into words is nice, even if you don't end up reading it. So thank you.

I know my parents really did put in a lot of care in naming me, and especially with how tense things may be after I come out to them, changing the name they gave me on top of that? I can't imagine how bad that would feel.

It especially sucks too, since I was named after my dad. I can't imagine the feeling, having finally given birth to your kid after however many failed attempts, and choosing to give that kid the greatest gift you could think of, your own name.

And then they just go and get rid of it?! I wouldn't want to do that to somebody. But, at the same time, trying to convince people I'm a girl while having my dad's masculine as hell name? I've gotta make concessions somewhere. I'm doing this for me, I'm gonna upset people along the way, but if it's what will help me feel comfy in my own skin, then maybe it won't be so bad.

Enough of the sob story though. It's time for the name reveal you've been waiting for!

I decided to go with something pretty simple, just: "Gen".

What do you think? Not "Jen" with a J, not "Jennifer" or "Jenny", just "Gen"! I got it from the word Genesis, since I really want to approach this transition as a new beginning for myself.

I've been letting my fear and anxiety control me for the longest time, they've kept me from seeing who I am and being who I want to be, but I don't want that anymore.

Today marks the start of my new life, one where I know despite whatever happens, I'll actively be fighting for the best life I can have, and that's all that matters.

This got a bit long, but thanks for bearing with me!

And! Now I can sign with my real name!
